

## The Holly Jolly Holiday Scarf Crochet Pattern

\*Original pattern designed and written by Karen Moniz of Crochet Crafty © 2021. Enjoy!



### Materials

- Hook – 8.0 mm
- Yarn – Medium weight 4 in 2 colours  
(Bernat Premium Burgundy and Bernat Aran Sparkle were used in this photo. One skein of each should be enough.)
- \* 200 - 250 grams approx
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

### Stitch Legend

- Rw – row
- st(s) – stitch(es)
- ch(s) – chains(s)
- sl st – slip stitch
- SC - single crochet
- HDC - half double crochet
- LCS – linked crunch stitch
- LSC - linked single crochet
- \*note that these two abbreviations look similar so take care not to confuse them*
- YO - yarn over (the hook)
- \* - repeat

*Dimensions: 60 inches or 152 cm in length, 6 inches or 15 cm in width*

## Pattern

Beginning with the Burgundy Colour (Colour A), place a slip knot on your hook and ch 201 to begin.

### Row – 1

- CREATING OUR LINKED CRUNCH STITCH (LCS)  
-> Into the 2nd ch from the hook, place 1 sl st, then Y/O and insert hook back into the sl st you just created and pull up a loop, Y/O again and insert your hook into the next st to pull up another loop. You now have 5 loops on your hook. Y/O and pull through all five loops. You have created your first LCS.



- continue to repeat this method until you reach the end of your row until you have 1 st remaining
- into the last st, place 1 HDC
- snip your yarn and fasten off  
(You will have **200 stitches** in total)

### Row - 2 (adding Colour B: Aran Sparkle)

Keeping the right side of your work facing up, turn your row upside down so that your foundation chain is now on top.



- sl st into the very first ch and ch 1
- insert your hook back into the first chain and place 1 SC st
- CREATING A LINKED SINGLE CROCHET: -> next you will insert your hook into the left leg of the SC you just worked. (this is the vertical loop of the SC) Then continue to insert your hook into the next st to pull up a loop. You now have 3 loops on your hook. Y/O and pull through all 3 loops.



- \*repeat this LSC into every st until you reach the end of your row. Remember to always insert your hook into the left leg of the previous st before inserting into the next st. This is what links the sts together.

You will have 200 sts at the end of this and every row for the rest of the project.

**Row - 3 & 4**

- Repeat Row 2

**Row - 5**

- Repeat Row 1

**Row - 6 -> 17**

\*continue to repeat Row 2 - 5 until you reach Row 17

If you wish to make your scarf wider you can repeat Row 2-5 to your desired width
