

The Crossed Stitch

Crochet Pattern

Materials

Stitch Legend

R – Row	
st(s) - stitch(es)	
ch(s) - chains(s)	
DC - Double Crochet	
SK - skip	
* - repeat	
	st(s) – stitch(es) ch(s) – chains(s) DC - Double Crochet SK - skip

Pattern

This stitch is created using a chain in multiples of 2 + 1. For this sample I chained 20 + 1 = 21. Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 21 to begin.

R-1

- Into the 2nd ch from the hook, place 1 SC
- continue to place 1 SC into each ch to the end of the row
- Ch 3 and turn your work

Row one is complete = 20 sts

R-2

 sk the next st from the ch 3 and place 1 DC, then go back to the skipped st and place 1 DC into that st *

*Repeat this pattern to the end of the row until you have 1 st left

- place 1 DC into the last st
- ch 3 and turn your work
 - *Repeat row 2 as many times as you desire
