

The Crunched Single Crochet Stitch

Crochet Pattern

Materials

- Hook – any desired size
- Yarn – whichever weight matches your hook size
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Stitch Legend

- R* – Row
- st(s)* – *stitch(es)*
- ch(s)* – *chains(s)*
- SC* – *Single Crochet*
- Sl st* - *Slip stitch*
- FLO* - *Front Loop Only*
- * - *repeat*

Pattern

This stitch is created using a chain in multiples of 2 + 1. For this sample I chained 12 + 1 = 13.

Begin with a slip knot on your hook and ch 13 to begin.

R – 1

- Into the 2nd ch from the hook, place 1 SC
- into the next ch place a sl st

* continue to repeat this alternating st placement to the end of the row (you should end with the last st being a sl st)

- Ch 1 and turn your work

Row one is complete = 12 sts

R - 2

- place 1 SC into the FLO of the very first st then into the next st place a sl st into the full st (picking up both loops of the st)
- continue to repeat in this fashion to the end of the row
- Ch 1 and turn. You should still have 12 sts

*Continue repeating Row 2 for subsequent rows until you reach your desired size.

** To help keep you on track, try to be mindful of making sure you always stitch the opposite of the row beneath. Ex: always place a SI St on top of a SC and always place a SC on top of a SI St
