

# Super Easy Stitch Hat

## Crochet Pattern

Materials	Stitch Legend
- Size 5.5 mm hook - Medium weight 4 yarn (I used <i>Patons Canadiana</i> yarn in this pattern)	Rnd – round st(s) – stitch(es) ch(s) – chains(s) sl st – slip stitch SC – single crochet HDC – half double crochet TC – triple crochet



Begin with a slip knot

Round	Description	End stitch count
Foundation	- ch 22 + 1	
Row 1	- In second ch from hook 1 SC into the back loop of every stitch across, = 22 stitches - ch 1 and turn your work *	22
Row 2 -75	- * repeat row 1 for approx. 75 rows or as many as you need for the fabric to wrap around the head snugly - once you have enough rows, bring the top end and bottom end together and slip stitch to seam together to create a tube - use the log tail of the yarn to sew one end together to create the top of your hat. DONE!	22
