

## The Vintage Jar Topper

### Crochet Pattern

### Materials

- **Hook** : 4.5mm aka G/7
- **Yarn** : Medium 4 weight (Cotton is recommended)
- **Hair Tie or Rubber Band**
- **Scissors**
- **Yarn Needle**

### Stitch Legend

- *Rnd* – rnd
- *st(s)* – stitch(es)
- *ch(s)* – chains(s)
- *sl st* – slip stitch
- *DC* - double crochet
- *SC* - single crochet
- \* - repeat

## Pattern

Begin with a cinch circle or magic ring and chain 4. This will count as a DC, ch1.

### Rnd – 1

- DC, ch 1 into the ring\* \*Repeat this 10 more times
- then pull your tail and cinch the center of the circle shut
- sl st into the 3rd chain of the initial chain 4 from the beginning of the round

You will have a total of 12 DC with 12 ch spaces which gives you 24 sts in total.



### Rnd – 2

- Sl st into the next space and ch 3
- Place 1 more DC into that same space
- Continue to place 2 DC into each ch space
- Sl st to the top of the ch 3 to join

Your stitch count remains at 24 sts.



### Rnd – 3

- Sl st into the next st, then sl st into the space between the next set of two sts
- Ch 4 (this counts as a DC, ch 1)
- Into the next space between the two little clusters of V's, place 3 DC and ch 1\*
- \*Repeat this into each space between the clusters until you arrive at your initial ch 4 and into that space right beside the ch 4, place 2DC
- Sl st to the top of the 3rd chain to join your round

You will now have 36 sts (without counting the chain spaces.)



## Rnd – 4

In this round you will crochet your hair tie into the project.

- Pressing the hair tie against the back of your work, insert your hook into the first st and SC to trap the tie
- Continue to SC into every st, including the spaces until the end of the round and your tie is completely covered.



- Sl st to join your round.

You will now have 48 sts in total.

## Rnd – 5

- Ch 3, place 1 DC back into the same st (this counts as 2 DC into the first st)
- 2 DC into each st all the way around
- Sl st to the top of the ch 3 to join your round

You will now have 96 sts in total.

Snip your yarn and fasten off.

\*Note: I used up scrap yarn for the Topper photographed, which is why it's in different colours.
